Objectives:

- · Health care system, its delivery and visits to health centers
- National health programmes and policies
- · Universal precautions and vaccinations
- · Patient safety and biohazard safety
- Principles of primary care(general and community based care)

(b) Enable the learner to acquire enhanced skills in:

- Language

- Communication emphasis on clinico-laboratory communication

The time committed for the Foundation Course may not be used for any other curricular activity. The Foundation Course shall have a minimum of 75% attendance of all students mandatorily. This will be certified by the Principal/Dean of the College.
